PART-TIME, PROGRAM A

10 hours per week (2 hours per day)

Monday — Friday
Morning, afternoon, or evening hours
Course length: 2 — 48 weeks

PART-TIME, PROGRAM B

15 hours per week (3 hours per day)

Monday — Friday 11am — 2pm
Course length: 2 — 48 weeks

Program offered in all levels: beginner to advanced.
Covers practical conversation, practical grammar, reading, writing, and pronunciation.

FULL-TIME, PROGRAM A

18 hours per week

18 hours on weekdays OR
18 hours on weekdays + weekends
Course length: 4 — 48 weeks

Master English plus elective course. Various schedules offered for this program including morning, afternoon, evening, and weekend hours. Rates vary depending on schedule. Program offered in all levels: beginner to advanced. Covers practical conversation, practical grammar, reading, writing, pronunciation, and elective.

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FULL-TIME, PROGRAM B**21 hours per week**

21 hours on weekdays

Course length: 4 — 48 weeks

Master English plus two elective courses. Program offered in all levels: beginner to advanced. Covers practical conversation, practical grammar, reading, writing, pronunciation, and electives.

FULL-TIME, PROGRAM C**23 hours per week**

23 hours on weekdays + weekends

Course length: 4 — 48 weeks

Master English plus two weekend elective courses. Program offered in all levels: beginner to advanced. Covers practical conversation, practical grammar, reading, writing, pronunciation, and electives.

ELECTIVE COURSES:

These specialized courses are made available for students to improve particular skills in their English language acquisition. Courses are meant to be taken in conjunction with the Master Speaking program. **Not all electives are available for all schedules and levels.**

Communication Skills

Designed to complement the Master Speaking course with more of a focus on communication skills and to improve the student's use of practical English for everyday life.

Writing

Designed to improve the writing skills of the student in the shortest period of time. This course incorporates exercises which target the different elements of writing in English, in conjunction with daily compositions.

Business English

Study English in the business capital of the world — New York City! The purpose of this course is to teach the student the English language skills needed to function effectively in a business setting.

Accent Reduction

This course covers all areas of pronunciation and accent reduction. You will improve your ability to speak like an American and understand day-to-day modern American English.

Current Events

The teacher will supply level-appropriate material using a wide variety of sources including articles, journals, blogs, interviews, etc. to encourage critical thinking and competence in expressing and supporting student opinions with confidence.

American Literature

The objective of this course is to increase student awareness of American culture while developing reading, vocabulary, and communication skills through short stories, poetry, essays, and exercises.
